7. Separate supporting staff for the B.Ed department has not been appointed.
8. Original FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakh and Rs. 3.00 lakh are not submitted towards endowment fund and reserve fund respectively into joint account in the name of institution and RD, ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar.

No reply received from the institution in response to Show Cause Notice till date.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-16.

Permission order to the institution for conducting D.El.Ed. course with an additional annual intake of 50 students, thus making the total annual intake of 100 vide this office order No. 24211 dated 24.02.2014 from the academic session 2014-2015 subject to fulfilling the following conditions :-

- (i) All staff as per the norms and standards of NCTE is in place by February 2014.
- (ii) There is an adequate budgetary allocation in the budget of the State Government for the year 2014-15, for provision of requisite infrastructure as per the norms and standards of NCTE.

In response to 7(9) and relaxation granted by the NCTE Hqrs, the institution has submitted its reply received in this office on 18.02.2014. After considering the reply of the institution the committee observed as under:

1. The institution submitted a list of 01 principal + 05 lecturers whereas the faculty for Additional Intake in D.El.Ed course is required 01 principal + 08 lecturers (Methodology course) + one lecturer for Physical education and one lecturer for Fine arts/Music. The institution has not submitted full fresh faculty list as per requirement duly approved by the competent authority.
2. The institution has not submitted a fresh blue print of building plan duly approved by a Govt Engineer.
3. The institution has not submitted building completion certificate issued by a Govt Engineer.
4. The institution has not submitted any letter from the State Govt regarding the budgetary provision.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

1. College, Mahuda (Dhanbad) which is 40 Km</p>		

away from our institution. When the members of this visiting team reached to our institution they started going through our original documents by comparing the same through the relevant papers submitted by us earlier. In this process, more than two hours time had been spent & it became near about 6.30 o'clock of the evening. Then they asked us for physical verification. As it was too late we requested the members to start physical verification on next day, but they did not take heed of our request and said that on next day they have scheduled to visit another B.Ed college situated at Ranchi which is also most important assignment for them. The team started their work when it was sun set & in deem light they started physical verification of our institution which is consisting of two Blocks A & B adjacent to each other but unfortunately roughly they have assessed the built up are of the building without measuring the actual measurement of these two Block A & B. We became surprise to note that the total measurement of Block A & B of our institution is 2000.48 sq.mts. (the details of which is submitted earlier) whereas report of the visiting team shows that it is 1300 sq.mts. only. We could not understand when they did not measured whole are by using any measurement Tap, then how it is calculated.”

It is very pertinent to mention that in Block A which is a four story building consisting offices, staff rooms, class rooms, five laboratories & one hall of 371sq.mts (three hundred seventy one) and block B also a four story building consisting a Girl’s common room, ICT-cum-ET lab, Library, Smart class room etc. Photographs of these two Block A & B is being enclosed herewith for your perusal & ready reference.”

(iii) The fact on record in the Visiting Team report and the reply of the institution are contradictory.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

Manik Mandal, Chief Vigilance Officer has submitted a letter vide No. 9-4/2014/NCTE/Vig dated 29<sup>th</sup> September 2014 regarding complaint against the ERC in processing the application of K.D. College of Education, Buxar, Bihar and informed that the Fact Finding Committee constituted by NCTE to inquiry into the complaints received had examined the original file of the institution and had made the following observations:-

Besides, even if it is assumed that the decision of the ERC in its 170<sup>th</sup> meeting to issue formal order of recognition was in order, the decision was taken by the ERC on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2014 and 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2014 being Sunday, the minutes were hosted by the ERC in its website on 03.03.2014. Therefore, there was no possibility of the institution getting new lecturers selected and appointed with the approval of the affiliating University after following the prescribed procedure and submitted the documents to the ERC on the same day. But, if the documents submitted by the institution to the ERC on 03.03.2014 in respect of new faculty selected and appointed by the institution is to be believed, the institution completed all the formalities with the approval of the affiliating University, Ara, Bihar and submitted the documents to ERC, Bhubaneswar within a day on 03.03.2014. Prima-facia the documents furnished by the institution regarding selection and appointment of the new faculty is fake. But, the Regional Director, ERC accepted the documents and issued order of formal recognition to the institution vide order dated 03.03.2014 in violation of provisions in the NCTE Act / Regulations.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

1. A copy of the letter received from Sh Manik Mandal, CVO may be forwarded to the institution for explanation.
2. The NCTE Hqrs may be requested to provide the report of the Fact Finding Committee with supporting documents if any regarding their findings/observations to enable the ERC to take appropriate action.
