## Order

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Kameshwar Singh Darbhanga Sanskrit University**, **Darbhanga – 846 008**, **Bihar** had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.)** course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students.

- 2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
  - i. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
  - ii. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
  - iii. The institution has selected one Reader and 07 (seven) lecturers for the said course
- 3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Kameshwar Singh Darbhanga Sanskrit University, Darbhanga 846 008, Bihar for Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.) Course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:
  - a. The institution shall ensure that the Principal and 07 (seven) faculty members ded qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 100 students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of the commencement of the academic session.
  - b. The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by UGC. / State Govt.
  - c. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

- 4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc.
- 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
