ORDER

WHEREAS, Veer Kunwar Singh University, Department of Education, Dist.-Bhojpur, Ara, Bihar-802301 (Code No.APE00529) was granted recognition for B.Ed. course with an intake of 100 vide ERC's order No.3508 dated 04.10.2006, followed by revised order vide No.32507 dated 30.05.2015 with an intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions in respect of enhancement of additional built up area, additional infrastructure, additional fund, additional staff, maintain and update website and to comply the same to the ERC.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 244th meeting held on 8th -9th October, 2017 considered the matter and recognition granted to B.Ed. course was withdrawn u/s 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session vide ERC's order No.54736 dated 18.10.2017 on the grounds mentioned therein.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE HQs. against the withdrawal order of ERC and the Appellate Authority vide order No.89-769/E-56196/2017 Appeal/3rd Mtg.-2019/16th February, 2019/76687 dated 27.03.2019 remanded back the case to ERC with a direction to consider the approved faculty to be submitted to them by the appellate and take further action as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The appellant is directed to forward to the ERC the approved faculty list submitted in the appeal within 15 days of receipt of orders on the appeal.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 271st meeting held on 24-25 April, 2019 re-viewed the matter in accordance with the appeal order as well as document submitted by the institution vide letter dated 28.03.2019 and decided as under:-

Recognition to B.Ed. course with an intake of 100 (two basic units) be continued from the academic session 2019-2020 with intimation to the institution, and all concerned.

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, recognition to B.Ed. course of two years duration with an intake of 100 (two basic units) of the institution viz. Veer Kunwar Singh University, Department of Education, Dist.-Bhojpur, Ara, Bihar-802301 (Code No.APE00529) is hereby continued from the academic session 2019-2020 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions under NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.

IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

6. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc., as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

10. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

11. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.

12. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
