Order

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In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Women's Primary Teachers Education College, Chhatauni, Motihari, East Champaran, Bihar** for **Elementary Teacher Education Course** of one year duration from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty)** students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall appoint / function with Principal and 05 teaching staff and supporting staff possessing the qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms before the commencement of academic session 2002-2003 in the salary structure prescribed by the Central Government/ State Government as the case may be.
2. The institution shall ensure laboratories by 30th September 2002 and also Educational Journals, library, and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
3. The institution shall ensure hostel facilities by 30th September 2002.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating Board/ State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating Board/ State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating Board/ examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution shall switch over to Two-year course from the academic session 2004-2005.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Performance Appraisal Report within 45 days of the last examination/ academic session every year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 8 above.

If **Women's Primary Teachers Education College, Chhatauni, Motihari, East Champaran, Bihar** contravenes any of the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
