AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Elementary Teacher Education (D.El.Ed) programme such as instructional facilities, intrastructural tacilities, iibitary accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
- 3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Gurukul Teachers' Training Centre, Gurukul Teachers' Training Centre, Plot No.23, 21, 19, 18, 17 & 21/837, Vill-Kutigram More, Tehsil/Taluka/Town/City- Rampurhat, P.O-Rampurhat, Dist-Birbhum, West Bengal-731224 for conducting D.El.Ed. Course Elementary (level) of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) from a cademic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- 4. The recognition is subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (vi) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:

 - c. Staff Profile
 - d. Recognition letter
 - e. Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and of the required conditions.
- 5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
- 6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available on NCTE swebsite www.ncte-india.org within 60 days of the issue of the order.
