ORDER

In terms of NCTE Regulations notified in the Gazette of India, February 24, 1996, **Govt. Teachers Training College, Malda, West Bengal- 732 101** had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for additional intake in the existing **B.Ed.** course of **One** year duration from the academic session **2003-2004** with an additional annual intake of **92 (Ninety-two)** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above-mentioned land.
 - (iii) The institution has developed the instructional and infrastructural facilities as per norms.
 - (iv) The institution has appointed ten teaching staff for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the affiliating university.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Govt. Teachers Training College, Malda, West Bengal- 732 101** for **B.Ed.** Course of **One** year duration from the academic session **2003-2004** with an additional annual intake of **62 (Sixty-two)** in addition to already approved **80 (Eighty)** students (making the total intake **142**), subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - a) The institution shall ensure that Principal and four part-time lecturers qualified as per NCTE norms are in position before commencement of the academic session.
 - b) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirement as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Govt. etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
