**Order**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Prabharani Institute of Education (B.Ed. College) Vill-Chanak, Po – Chanak, Plot No-507,508,512, City- Berhampore, Dist – Murshidabad, West Bengal – 742074 (Code No. APE00886) made application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for conducting B.Ed. Course (Additional Course) with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) on dt.31.12.2007.

2. AND WHEREAS in its 106<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23-25 July, 2008 the Eastern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, is satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reason:

- i. The experience certificate of the Principal is of a Secondary School which is not as per NCTE norms.

3. AND WHEREAS grant of reconition/permission to **Prabharani Institute of Education (B.Ed. College) Vill-Chanak, Po – Chanak, Plot No-507,508,512, City- Berhampore, Dist – Murshidabad, West Bengal – 742074** for the Course in terms of section 15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, was refused vide order No.ERC/7-106(1s).4.2/2010/3852 dt.02.05.2010.

4. AND WHEREAS the Institution namely, **Prabharani Institute of Education (B.Ed. College) Vill-Chanak, Po – Chanak, Plot No-507,508,512, City- Berhampore, Dist – Murshidabad, West Bengal – 742074** (hereinafter referred to as the applicant), preferred an appeal dated 28.05.2010 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the above said Order.

5. AND WHEREAS as per the Appeal Order Sh. P.K. Sarkar, AO & Sh. S.K. Ray, Adviser, Prabharani Institute of Education, Murshidabad, West Bengal presented the case of the appellant institution on 19.07.2010. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that the selection of the earlier principal was made by a committee comprising three experts of Kalyani University as he was having a Ph.D degree and ERC did not raise any objection regarding his experience at that time. He also submitted that the management has since selected a new principal as per the NCTE norms. The appellant submitted the proceedings of the selection committee, experience certificates of the newly selected principal, namely Dr. Ruma Deb and also stated that the new principal was offered the post on 30.06.2010 and she has accepted the offer.

6. AND WHEREAS the Council, taking into account the submissions made by the appellant and also nothing that the newly appointed principal Dr. Ruma Deb has been possessing qualification & experience as per NCTE norms; came to the conclusion that the appeal deserved to be accepted and the order of ERC be reversed with the direction to ERC to grant formal recognition to the institution.

7. AND WHEREAS having considered the verbal submission by the representative of the institution the written representation, the original record of the case and V.T. Report, the Council decided to reverse the order of ERC. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and ERC's order dated 02.05.2010 was reversed with a direction to the ERC to grant formal recognition/permission to the institution within 15 days of issue of this order F.No.-89-555/2010-Appeal/A23737 dated 31.08.2010.

8. The original file along with other documents, the order of the appellate authority and Rules and Regulation, norms and Standards, NCTE Act were placed before the Committee in 111<sup>th</sup> ERC meeting and the Committee noted the decision of the appellate authority.

9. NOW, THEREFORE, as per the appeal order dt.31.08.2010 and in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Prabharani Institute of Education (B.Ed. College) Vill-Chanak, Po – Chanak, Plot No-507,508,512, City- Berhampore, Dist – Murshidabad, West Bengal – 742074** for conducting **B.Ed. Course** (Additional Course) of **one year** duration with an annual intake of **100 students** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) existing Regulation in vogue subject to fulfillment of the following:

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- (i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012 only.
- (ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days the session is fulfilled as per the calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.
- (iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 7(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (vi) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
