**Order**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Mankundu B.Ed. College, PO.- Mankundu, Dist.- Hooghly, West Bengal- 712 139** has submitted an application (Code No.APE01188) to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting B.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 100 on dt.31.10.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS in its 106<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20-22 April, 2010 the Eastern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, is satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reason:

(i) The Principal Shanti Sarkar has produced two certificates of two stations of the same time period which is not acceptable.

3. AND WHEREAS grant of recognition to **Mankundu B.Ed. College, PO.- Mankundu, Dist.- Hooghly, West Bengal- 712 139** for the B.Ed. Course in terms of section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, was refused vide order No.ERC/7-106(1s)4.5/2010 Dt.30.04.2010.

4. AND WHEREAS the Institution, **Mankundu B.Ed. College, PO.- Mankundu, Dist.- Hooghly, West Bengal- 712 139**, preferred an appeal dated 15.09.2010 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the above said Order.

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5. AND WHEREAS Shri. Swapon Kumar Mandal, Chairman and Shri Subhabrata Majumdar, member, Mankundu B.Ed. College, Hooghly, West Bengal presented the case of the appellant institution on 09.08.2010. In the appeal and during personal presentation, it was submitted that it did not come to the notice of the institution that the Principal submitted experience certificates from two Institutions at the same time period. As soon as it came to the notice of the institution, it unanimously adopted a resolution a resolution to terminate him from the post of Principal and also resolved to advertise fro the post of Principal and accordingly appointed a new Principal through an interview by a properly continued selection committee consisting of 6 professors of different universities.

6. **AND WHEREAS** the Council noted that the institution selected another Principal who was qualified as per the NCTE norms. In the circumstances, the Council was of the view that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and reverse the ERC's order.

7. **AND WHEREAS** after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, VT Report, affidavit and after considering oral arguments advanced during hearing, the Council reaches the conclusion that there as enough ground to accept the appeal and reverse the ERC's order dated 30.04.2010. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and ERC's order dated 30.04.2010 was reversed with a direction to the ERC to grant formal recognition to the institution immediately.

8. AND WHEREAS the matter of the institution was again placed in 114<sup>th</sup> ERC along with along with other documents, the order of the appellate authority and Rules and Regulation, norms and Standards, NCTE Act and the Committee decided to issue Unconditional Recognition order under Clause 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 for B.Ed Course with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2010-2011.

9. NOW, THEREFOE, as per the appeal order dt. 15.09.2010 and in excise of the powers vested under section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Mankundu B.Ed. College, PO.- Mankundu, Dist.- Hooghly, West Bengal- 712 139** for conducting **B.Ed. course of one year** duration with an annual intake of **100 students** from the **academic session 2010-2011**, under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) existing Regulation in vogue subject to fulfillment of the following:



- (i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cutoff date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012 only.
- (ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days the session is fulfilled as per the calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.
- (iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (vi) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (a) Copy of the Application Form
- (b) Land and Building Particulars
- (c) Staff Profile
- (d) Recognition letter
- (e) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.



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13. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
