Order

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the Kolkata Teachers' Training College, Vill. Panpur, P.O. Narayanpur, Dist. 24 Parganas (N), West Bengal-743126 has submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 250 (two hundred fifty) students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team report, the Committee is satisfied that the institution / society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education Programme (B.Ed.) such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected / appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Kolkata Teachers' Training College, Vill. Panpur, P.O. Narayanpur, Dist. 24 Parganas (N), West Bengal-743126 for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students with effect from issue of this order. The institution shall ensure the fulfillment of the following:-

- The institution will ensure that the teaching faculty (1(one) Principal +7 (seven) teachers) members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee before the commencement of the course, and information be put up in the institution website as per NCTE regulation 2005, notified in Gazette of India dated 13th January, 2006:
- The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by UGC/University through Account Payee Cheque.

- c) The number of administrative staff shall be maintained as per NCTE norms. The qualifications of technical support staffs shall be maintained as per norms prescribed by concerned affiliating University / UGC. The qualifications of the administrative staff shall be maintained as per norms prescribed by concerned State Govt/affiliating University.
  - d) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Eastern Regional Committee.
  - e) The Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. 3.00 lakh be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/ institution.
  - f) The institution shall obtain affiliation from the examining body before the commencement of the course.
  - g) The institution shall maintain and update their website as per NCTE regulations.
  - h) Apart from the qualifications prescribed for teachers for B.Ed. Course, the candidate shall have to qualify NET/SLET qualifications or alternative qualifications thereto as prescribed by UGC from time to time before the commencement of the academic session 2009 - 2010.
  - i) The intake, eligibility and admission procedure shall be strictly adhered as per NCTE norms.
  - j) Performance Appraisal Report shall be submitted by the end of every academic year on the prescribed format.
  - k) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Eastern Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
